1. Students may move up **one grade** to play tougher competition if you choose.
2. All Junior and Senior Boys will play in the "Men's Top-Gun competition".
3. Co-Ed Teams must have at least 2 girls/women on the team.
4. Students choosing to play in both Co-Ed and their particular grade level **MAY DO SO!**
We try to set up the brackets so times will not conflict. Co-Ed games will most likely be played on Sunday (morning or afternoon).
5. High School Teams won't play until after noon on Saturday or Sunday to avoid any conflicts with any other sporting commitments.
6. Juniors and Seniors, and Men and Women's divisions will only play Saturday afternoon/evening and possibly on Sunday mornings. **We will do our best** to not overlap those that play both Co-Ed and other divisions.
7. Student players do not have to be from the same school, allowing for a great opportunity to team up with that long-lost cousin or buddy from another school. Or, in the case of the women...get Mom to play and let her prove how awesome she is!!!
8. **3-POINT CONTEST.** Your entry fee automatically makes you eligible to participate.
A 45-second attempt to score as many 3's as you can from the top of the arc.
Competition held at times posted on available courts, just show up - you're included!
9. **UNIQUE UNIFORM CONTEST** - Certificates handed out throughout the tournament. Keep your designs safe, clean and tasteful!
10. **SLAM DUNK CONTEST** - Saturday Afternoon/Evening. On 10 ft. rim, adults only - - graded in 3 categories by our judges. Prizes will be awarded.

ENTRY FEES

Registration \$80 per team.

Entry fee entitles your 4-player team (and one coach for grades six and under) to

FREE ENTRY

for the entire tournament.

Wrist bracelets will be issued at time of entry at the registration tables.

REGISTRATION

All teams need to register at least 30-45 minutes before your first game time. Bring proof of grade/age; such as: report card, student I.D. with photo, birth certificate, yearbook with photo, social security card or passport.

Adults simply need a driver's license.

All "Little People" (pre-school and 1st graders) will receive a Participant Trophy.

First place winners in all other divisions, grades 2-10 will receive 4 individual trophies.

Second place finishers in each graded (2-10) division will win 4 trophies per team.

Third place finishers in each graded (2-10) division will receive 4 medals per team.

This year the first 150 graded teams will receive 4 basketballs (not tee-shirts) per team at registration.

BOYS 7th thru 10th GRADE and ADULT DIVISIONS

Receive 4 tee-shirts per team at registration.

ALL HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS/WOMEN JUNIOR & SENIOR BOYS & MEN

First and second place finishers will receive 4 trophies per team in each division.

3-Point Contest winners will win an individual trophy.

Levels will be as follows:

For Boys/Men: High School and Adult • 7th and 8th Grade • 5th & 6th Grade • 3rd & 4th Grade
Pre-School, 1st & 2nd Grade Boys

For Girls/Women: High School and Adult • 7th & 8th Grade • 5th & 6th Grade • 3rd & 4th Grade
